Ken is retired from the US Marine Corps where he served as an Infantry Squad Leader. Ken was wounded in Afghanistan by a roadside bomb that left him with 3rd degree burns over 50% of his body. Ken was awarded a Purple Heart and the Marine Commendation Medal for valor in combat. Jeff is medically retired from the US Marine Corps after serving as a Machine Gunner in Anbar, Iraq. Jeff was wounded in two separate IED attacks, suffering traumatic brain injuries and a torn achilles tendon. Ken and Jeff will be hunting elk with Camo Cares this fall in New Mexico.
